### **REUNION VENUE - TAUPŌ**

Your National Executive is organising our next National Reunion in Taupō 1 – 4 November 2024.

**THE FOCUS OF THE REUNION is about spouses/partners, children, and grandchildren.** We want as many children and grandchildren to attend as possible, so we are making this a great family weekend.

This will be an opportunity for children and grandchildren to meet and build the connections that will support the next generations.

Due to the good work of previous executives and representatives, the Association and its aligned trusts are in financial good health, with significant assets protected by trust deeds.

It is important that this asset base is available to assist our children and grandchildren in the years ahead. Your executive has started the handover process by ensuring that the children are well represented on the executive.

The updating of our Constitution and trust deeds will allow the handover of the assets to the children and grandchildren group as we fade away. We want to start this handover process at Reunion 24.

#### **Date & Venue**

The Reunion will be held at Taupō based at the Wairakei Resort Hotel from Friday 1 November until Monday morning 4 November 2024. (Note: No formal activities will be held on the Monday).

## Activities

Our plan is to have plenty of socialising time between formal events.

Formal parade in Taupō for our remembrance activity, with War Bird flyover and civic reception, Sunday morning

## Programme (provisional)

Our outline programme is as follows:

  - Two registration desks at Wairakei from midday to 1800
  - Afternoon - One-on-one meetings with Veteran Affairs case managers and individual veterans at Wairakei
  - 1400 – Check in to your accommodation
  - 1700 hrs Meet & Greet – Drinks (location TBA)
  - Evening - Fireworks Display (Taupō Lake Front)
- **Saturday 2 November 2024 (Wairakei)**
  - 0930 – 1100, Annual General Meeting
  - 1130 – 1230 and 1400 – 1530 – breakout meetings with Veterans Affairs for veterans, spouses/partners, children and grandchildren
  - 1800 to 2300 – Drinks followed by Reunion dinner
- **Sunday 3 November 2024**
  - Morning - Formal Parade and Memorial Service – Taupō waterfront, followed by Mayoral reception
  - Afternoon – Free for own activities – bus to/from National Army Museum if numbers warrant
- **Monday 4 November 2024**
  - 1000 - Check out and return home

## Costs

There will be a Reunion Registration fee for members and their families set at \$135 per adult and \$75 per child 15 years old and under. This will cover lunch and formal dinner Saturday and morning and afternoon teas, function room costs, shuttle bus to town, as well as admin costs.

We will arrange for the Association to run a “lay by” system for those that want to put some registration/accommodation money aside each fortnight/month in advance.
